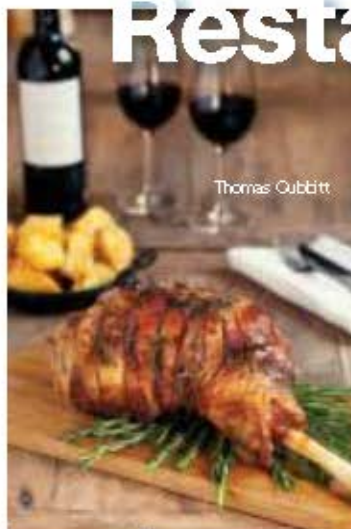
Le Sereno, St Barts

Restaurant

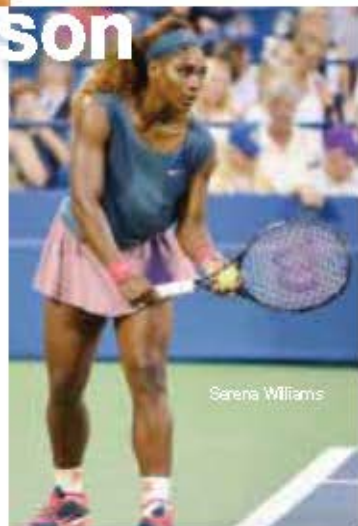


Thomas Cubitt
